

Certification for Lamar University Employees International Travel When Carrying Lamar University Owned, Export Administration Regulations (EAR) Controlled Items, Technology, and Software

Note: This form is ONLY required for & carrying Lamar owned Equipment Internationally. /f ANY export of Lamar owned or controlled property - whether by a researcher, student or administrator involves a US Restricted Party, involves ITAR items, technical data, or involves Iran, Cuba, Syria, Sudan or North Korea, you must receive approval from ORSPA.

The export of electronic devices, technology, commercial software, and encryption code is subject to export control regulations. These items include laptops, smart phones, tablets, and digital storage devices. The Department of Commerce's Export Administration Regulations (EAR) makes an exception to licensing requirements for the temporary export or reexport of certain items, technology, or software for professional use as long as the criteria to which you are certifying below are met. The exception does not apply to:

- x EAR satellite or space-related equipment, components, or software; or
- x Technology associated with high-level encryption products; or
- x Defense items, technology, data, or software regulated by the Department of State's International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR).
